This funding will be used to

- Build capacity of all class teachers through the Instruction coaching model of co-plan, co-teach and co-reflect
- Support the resourcing of the levelled reading program in the early and middle years
- Support extra curricular programs to promote high order thinking through the Optiminds initiative
- Support staff development and knowledge of the Digital Technologies curriculum

Our initiatives include

- Employ an Instructional Coach to co-lead the instructional coaching model, building the capacity of teachers in the co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect model (0.8)
- Employ tutor support to assist in the improvement of student achievement in NAPLAN reading and writing (Year 3 and 5)
- Assist in resourcing teams to participate in the Optiminds initiative in Science and Engineering, Literature and Language and Social Sciences
- Release teachers to support the implementation of the Digital Technologies curriculum

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Employment of an Instructional Coach (FTE 0.8) to build capacity in the co-plan, co-teach, co-reflect model (\$80 000)
- Engage students in a variety of higher order thinking projects (Optiminds) in Science and Literature (\$5000)
- Release staff to engage in professional development to build capacity in delivery of quality curriculum delivery with Instructional Coach, Head of Curriculum & Principal (\$16 000)
- Resourcing to support the delivery of the Digital Technologies curriculum (\$7 000)
